Description 60 count, 1 wall, Easy Intermediate Stationary (Line) Partner Waltz,
Same footwork, Standing side by side, facing down LOD. His R. hand to her R. hand at her Shoulder, L. to L. hands across front of man.

Music Old Double Diamond - Ian Tyson
Old Friend Scooter Lee
Your favorite waltz



1/4 turn Side together Balance Step

1-2-3 Step L. for. into 1/4 turn L. Step R. to R. side Slide L. together
4-5-6 Step R. back Step L. together Step R. in place
1-6 Repeat above turn and balance step

1/2 turn L. Balance Step

1-2-3 Step L. for. 1/2 turn L. Step R. Step L. (slightly back) Drop L. hand, man in R.
4-5-6 Step R. back Step L. together Step R. in place Hammerlock
1-6 Repeat above turn and balance step, holding L & releasing R. hands

Man's Basic Lady's 1/2 turn Balance Step

1-2-3 Man-step L,R,L for.
Lady step L. for. 1/2 turn L. Step R. back Step L. together - hands will be crossed,
4-5-6 Man- step R. L. for. Step R. slightly back Release to open hand
Lady step R. L. back Step R. slightly for. Pos.-facing man

Step Point Hold

1-2-3 Man-step L. back Point R. to R. side Hold 1 count
Lady step L. for. Point R. to R. side Hold 1 count
4-5-6 Man-step R. for. Point L. to L. side Hold 1 count
Lady step R. back Point L. to L. side Hold 1 count

3/4 Turn L.

1-2-3 Drop hands, Step L. R. L. into 3/4 turn L.
4-5-6 Step R. L. R. in place Open hand pos.(his L., her R. his R. her L) Partners are facing

Step Point Hold

1-6 Repeat above step, point, hold sequence

Forward and back with Turns

1-2-3 Man. Step L.R. L. in place 4-5-6 Step R.L. R. back with 1/4 turn L
Lady Step L.R.L. for. with 1/4 turn L. 4-5-6 1/2 turn L Step R.L.R. back
(Lady steps under man's R. arm, release hands, she is behind man, rejoin hands)
1-2-3 Man Drop R. hands, Step L.R.L. for. Into 1/4 turn L.
4-5-6 Step R. L. R. Back into 1/4 turn L. Facing forward line of dance
Lady Step L.R.L. For. into 1/4 turn L. Passing under man's L. arm
Step R.L.R. Back into 1/4 turn L. Returning to Man's R. side Re-join R. hands
